## INDEX OF RETAIL PRICES—FEBRUARY, 2002

## General Index

The All Items Index of Retail Prices calculated from prices collected for the month of February, 2002 was 146.6 showing a decrease of 0.4% below the Index for January, 2002.

The All Items Index for January–February, 2002 showed an increase of 4.8% over that for January–February, 2001. This compares with an increase of 5.4% observed in the Index for January–February, 2001 over the same period in 2000.

## Section Indices

Food: The Index for this section decreased from 264.2 in January, 2002 to 261.4 in February, 2002 indicating a 1.1% fall in the price of food items over this period. Within the Food Section there was a decrease of 3.0% in the Index for Market items. Contributing significantly to this decrease were falling prices of chicken, tomato, citrus fruits and cabbage. This decrease in prices were partly offset by an increase in the prices of pumpkin, melongene, green bananas and plantain.

Price changes in this section accounted for a decrease of 0.6 point in the All Items Index.

## Other Sections

A further review of the data for February, 2002 compared with the previous month, indicated an increase of 0.5% and 0.4% for Drink and Tobacco, and Household operations respectively. While a decrease of 0.5% was recorded for Clothing and Footwear.

Price changes in these sections had a negligible effect on the All Items Index.

Growth in consumer prices in February, 2002 compared with those of February, 2001 reflected in various sections of the Index is shown hereunder:—
