Any person wishing to be heard in opposition to the Bill must lodge with the Clerk of the Senate, a petition showing the nature of his objections to the Bill and stating whether his objections extend to the whole or some part of the preamble or to the clauses of the Bill and praying that he may be heard by himself or his counsel against the Bill.
