TENDERS FOR CONSTRUCTION WORKS UNDER THE PUBLIC SECTOR IMPROVEMENT PROGRAMME 1999–2000

TENDERS are invited for the following construction works under the Public Sector Improvement Programme 1999–2000:

- (a) Completion Works of Assaraff Road Walkover, located over the Uriah Butler Highway in the vicinity of Charlieville;
- (b) Construction of a Steel Pedestrian Overpass located at Pasea Road and Churchill-Roosevelt Highway Intersection.

2. Tender documents may be obtained during normal working hours at the Central Tenders Board's Office, 116, Frederick Street, Port-of-Spain. Telephone Numbers 625-4330; 3565; 1809 (Fax).

3. Tenderers are required to pay a tender deposit of three hundred dollars (\$300.00) to the Director of Contracts and attach the official receipt to their tender.

4. Further information may be obtained during normal working hours from the Director of Highways, Mr. V. Ragbir, Telephone Number 625-1981 or Chief Construction Engineer, Mr. Roger Ganesh, Telephone Number 625-4671.

5. The Chief Construction Engineer, Ministry of Works and Transport will hold a pre-tender meeting at his office at the Ministry of Works and Transport Building, Richmond Street, Port-of-Spain on Wednesday 12th July, 2000 at 10.00 a.m.

6. Tenderers are required to visit the sites and acquaint themselves with site conditions, which may influence or affect their offer. Site inspections will be arranged at the pre-tender meeting.

7. Separate bids must be submitted for each contract. Prospective contractors may tender for projects but may be awarded only one of them.

8. Prospective tenderers are advised to pay specific attention to Vol. I of IV—Instructions to tenderers.

9. The tender must remain valid and open for acceptance for a minimum period of one hundred and twenty (120) days after the date of tender opening.

10. Tenders must be accompanied by valid Income Tax and Value Added Tax Clearance Certificates issued by the Board of Inland Revenue and dated not more than six (6) months prior to the closing date of tender.

11. Sealed offers containing Volume III of IV of the Tender Documents completed and signed together with specified attachments will be received up to 1.00 p.m. on Thursday 27th July, 2000. The envelopes must be addressed to the Director of Contracts, Central Tenders Board, 116, Frederick Street, Port-of-Spain and must be marked on the outside as indicated and deposited in the Brown Tenders Box located in the lobby at the Board's Office. All tenders must be marked separately with the relevant subject as indicated below:
