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INVITATION FOR PREQUALIFICATION FOR CONSULTING SERVICES FOR FACILITIES MAINTENANCE
AND ENGINEERING—REFORM PROGRAMME LOAN NO. 937/OC-TT

THE GOVERNMENT OF THE REPUBLIC OF TRINIDAD AND TOBAGO has received funds from the Inter-American Development Bank (IDB) to partially finance its Health Sector Reform Program. It is intended that part of the proceeds of this financing will be applied to the provision of consulting services for the development of management and operating systems, staff development and training services, rationalization and health financing mechanisms. Consulting services for maintenance of acute care hospitals and primary healthcare facilities will be required as follows:

Health Facilities Maintenance and Engineering involves the institutional strengthening of the Maintenance and Engineering function in the RHAs. The consultancy would:

- (a) develop a comprehensive maintenance philosophy for the healthcare institutions;
- (b) strengthen the organization and management of the Maintenance function through—
 - (i) the establishment of a formal Maintenance and Engineering Department and Manager position; and
 - (ii) train/develop Maintenance Managers and staff;
- (c) recommend levels of budget, staffing and skills mix, workshop facilities and maintenance equipment;
- (d) prepare standard Policy and Procedure manuals;
- (e) assist in the implementation of a computerized maintenance management system;
- (f) establish a system for obtaining and disseminating manufacturers' equipment and medical device alerts; and
- (g) implement a central/shared service model for Biomedical Engineering Services for all RHAs (9 man-months international and 9 man-months local).

This invitation is open to local and foreign consulting firms or joint ventures from member countries of the IDB. Only firms meeting IDB nationality requirements will be applicable for consideration.

The intention is to short-list three to six eligible and qualified consulting firms for this consultancy based on set evaluation criteria.

A complete set of pre-qualification documents may be obtained by interested parties upon payment of a document fee of US\$16 (TT\$100) payable at the second address below by certified cheque to the Director of Contracts.
