PURSUANT to their powers under No. 70 of the Rules of Racing, The Trinidad and Tobago Racing Authority gives notices that with immediate effect, TETANUS Booster inoculations will no longer be consider a mandatory requirement under Rule 31(1)(c) for eligibility to take entry and race.

Owners and Trainers are however asked to note that Tetanus remains an obligatory vaccination for all horses, and particularly for horses born in Trinidad and Tobago (pursuant to No. 8 of the rules for Registration of Horses) in order to be active for racing initially. Such horses will not be placed on the Eligibility List for racing if their vaccination regime is not in order.

AMENDMENTS TO THE RULES FOR REGISTRATION OF HORSES

THE TRINIDAD AND TOBAGO RACING AUTHORITY gives notice of the following amendment to the Rules for Registration of Horses.

Foals

Rule 5(a) is amended.

(a) Registration

New paragraph 2, include:

A DNA kit will be sent to the owner of the foal specified on the Mare Return lodged with the Authority; which should be completed and returned to the Authority within 30 days on receipt of same.

Within a further 30 days on receipt of the DNA sample of the foal, the Authority shall have same sent to the laboratory. should the sample sent prove to be inconclusive for parentage verification, the process must be repeated and a new sample taken.

The above amendment to the Rules for Registration of Horses was approved at a meeting of the Trinidad and Tobago Racing Authority held on Thursday 14th September, 2000.
