THE GOVERNMENT OF THE REPUBLIC OF TRINIDAD AND TOBAGO has received funds from the Inter-American Development Bank (IDB) to partially finance its Health Sector Reform Programme (HSRP) Ministry of Health. The following consulting services for the institutional strengthening of primary health care promotion are now being sought.

- 1.1 Primary Health Care Development will build a co-ordinated and integrated system for the delivery of primary health care as a vital component of the HSRP (12 person-months international and 54 person-months local).
- 1.2 Health Promotion will build the capacity of individuals and communities to improve health and well-being. (12 person-months international).
- 1.3 Primary Health Care Technical Training will design a co-ordinated and integrated training and support programme for the delivery of primary health care in the public sector (12 person-months international and 24 person-months local).

This invitation is open to local and foreign consulting firms or joint venture from member countries of the IDB. Only firms meeting IDB nationality requirements will be eligible for consideration. Firms may submit prequalification data for one, two or all three of the above consultancies. The intention is to short-list six eligible and qualified consulting firms for each consultancy based on the following criteria:

- Legal Supporting Documents
- Financial Capacity
- Language Proficiency
- Experience
- Capacity of Firm
- Use of Local Professionals
