OFFER OF SCHOLARSHIPS BY THE ORGANISATION OF AMERICAN STATES—SEPTEMBER 2001 AWARDS

THE GOVERNMENT OF THE REPUBLIC OF TRINIDAD AND TOBAGO invites applications from nationals of Trinidad and Tobago for Scholarships being offered by the Organisation of American States effective from September, 2001 under the following programmes:

(A) REGULAR TRAINING PROGRAMME—POSTGRADUATE STUDIES

2. These scholarships are intended for graduate study or research for periods of not less than three (3) months nor more than two (2) years. Awards will not be granted in the fields of Medicine, Dentistry and para-medical studies.

3. Applicants must present proof that they are currently enrolled in or have applied for acceptance to pursue the specific programme for which they are seeking to be granted scholarships.

(B) CARIBBEAN AREA SPECIAL FELLOWSHIP (SPECAP) PROGRAMME

4. Awards will be available for study leading to a Bachelor's degree in programmes of one (1) or two (2) years duration at the "Junior" or "Senior" level (penultimate or final year).

5. Applicants must present proof that they are due to proceed or have applied for acceptance to the "Junior" or "Senior" year of a Bachelor's degree programme in respect of the 2001 academic year.

6. Successful candidates under the SPECAP Programme will receive no financial assistance from the Government of Trinidad and Tobago while those who hold permanent appointments in the Public Service will be granted No-Pay Study Leave to enable them to take up their awards.

7. Preference may be given to study in the following areas or sectors which have been identified as priority in terms of the country's human resource requirements:

Energy/Petroleum, Agriculture/Agro Industry, Tourism, Manufacturing, Health, Education, Construction, Information/Telecommunication Technology, Trade/Economic Development, Transport, Environment Services, Legal and Financial Services.
