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REVOCATION OF APPOINTMENT OF A TRANSIT SHED (*Customs Act, Chap. 78:01*)

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OFFER OF SCHOLARSHIPS FOR THE M.Sc. IN PLANNING AND DEVELOPMENT AT THE
UNIVERSITY OF THE WEST INDIES, ST. AUGUSTINE

THE GOVERNMENT OF THE REPUBLIC OF TRINIDAD AND TOBAGO invites applications from nationals of the Republic of Trinidad and Tobago for the award of six (6) scholarships to enable the successful candidates to pursue the M.Sc. degree in Planning and Development at the University of the West Indies (UWI), St. Augustine, commencing from the academic year 2000-2001. The training is intended for the Ministry of Housing and Settlements.

Eligibility

All applicants must—

- (a) be citizens of the Republic of Trinidad and Tobago;
- (b) possess at least a Second Class Honours Bachelor's degree in Urban and/or Regional Planning, Land Surveying, Engineering, Architecture, Sociology, Economics and Political Science all with required competence in Mathematics, Statistics and Computing.

Notwithstanding (b) above, applications will also be considered from mature students possessing a combination of work experience and training acceptable by the University of the West Indies (UWI) for admission to the programme.

The award of a scholarship would be conditional upon the candidate being admitted to the programme of study by the University of the West Indies (UWI), St. Augustine.

Preparation and Submission of Application

Application forms and detailed information concerning the prescribed conditions for the submission of applications and terms of the awards should be obtained from the following offices:
