# INDEX OF RETAIL PRICES - JULY, 2001

### General Index

The All Items Index of Retail Prices calculated from prices collected for the month of July, 2001 was 142.3 showing a decrease of 0.1% under the Index for June, 2001.

The All Items Index for January - July, 2001 showed an increase of 5.6% over that for January - July, 2000. This compares with an increase of 3.2% observed in the Index for January - July, 2000 over the same period in 1999.

## Section Indices

Food: The Index for this section decreased by 0.3% from 245.9 in June, 2001 to 245.1 in July, 2001. Within the Food Section there was a decrease of 0.7% in the Index for Market items. Contributing significantly to this decrease were falling prices of tomatoes, melongene, chicken and cucumber. These decreases in prices were partly offset by an increase in the prices of green bananas, plantain, sweet and Irish potato.

Price changes in this section accounted for a decrease of 0.1 point in the All Items Index.

#### Other Sections

A further review of the data for July, 2001 compared with the previous month, indicated that increases were recorded for Meals out, 0.2%; Household Supplies and Services, 0.3%; Health and Personal Care, 0.7%; and Reading, Recreation and Education, 0.6%. A decrease of 0.4% was recorded for Household operations.

The net effect of price changes in these sections on the All Items Index was negligible.

Growth in consumer prices in July, 2001 compared with those of July, 2000 reflected in various sections of the Index is shown hereunder:-
