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#### APPOINTMENT OF A SUFFERANCE WHARF

IN ACCORDANCE with section 2 of the Customs Act, Chap. 78:01, I, Kawanhar Doopan, Comptroller of Customs and Excise, hereby gives notice of the appointment of a Sufferance Wharf as indicated in the Schedule hereto:

### SCHEDULE—SUFFERANCE WHARF

The Pier numbered 1 measuring 63.4 x 4.9 metres, a total area of 310.66 metres, leased by Sun Island Cruises from Chaguaramas Development Authority, situate in that portion of Chaguaramas Bay, in the area known as Anse Tringuant.

#### Provided:

- (a) that no vessel shall bring to in this area without the permission of the Harbour Master, Port Health, the Comptroller of Customs and Excise or other lawful authority, having first been obtained;
- (b) that no cargo shall be loaded or unloaded;
- (c) that no drawback, ex warehouse or bonded goods or ships' stores shall be shipped, except with the written permission of the Comptroller, Customs and Excise;
- (d) that no plant material (fruits and vegetables) will be permitted entry;
- (e) that no passengers shall embark and disembark except with the permission of the Comptroller of Customs and Excise having first been obtained;
- (f) that the Customs and Excise Baggage Officer be first informed of the Departure and arrival of the vessel, twenty-four (24) hours in advance;
- (g) that the Customs and Excise Officer, Western Peninsula grants clearance;
- (h) that the vessel must first report to the Officer in Charge, Western Peninsula before permission is granted to proceed to Pier 1.
