OFFER OF SCHOLARSHIPS UNDER THE NETHERLANDS FELLOWSHIP PROGRAMME—2002/2003 AWARDS

THE GOVERNMENT OF THE REPUBLIC OF TRINIDAD AND TOBAGO invites applications from nationals of the Republic of Trinidad and Tobago for scholarships available under The Netherlands Fellowship Programme for post-graduate studies commencing from the 2002/2003 academic year.

- 2. Applications are invited for the pursuit of Master's degree programmes in the areas of Development Oriented Studies; Management and Business; Medical and Related Sciences and Science and Technology as detailed in The Netherlands Fellowship Programme 2002/2003 Brochure. Applicants will be required to state the exact course and specialization, if applicable, for which they are applying
- 3. Preference may be given to study in those areas or sectors which have been identified as priority in terms of the country's human resource requirements.

Eligibility Criteria

- 4. Applicants must meet the general criteria listed below-
 - (a) be a citizen of Trinidad and Tobago;
 - (b) have at least a good Bachelor's degree (Second Class Honours) from a recognised institution in a relevant field of study or the course-specific requirements listed under the selected course;
 - (c) have a minimum of two (2) years professional experience or the course-specific requirements listed under the selected course;
 - (d) provide a statement from his/her employer, in the case of persons other than Public Officers, pledging to continue payment of the candidate's salary and to hold the candidate's job for him/her while he/she is in The Netherlands;
 - (e) be no older than forty (40) years as a male applicant and forty-five (45) years as a female applicant;
 - (f) must not have studied abroad or received training abroad in the recent past.

Preparation and Submission of Applications

- 5. Interested persons are advised that application forms and detailed information concerning the terms of awards and the prescribed conditions for the submission of applications should be obtained from the following offices:
 - (a) Scholarships and Advanced Training Division, Ministry of Human Development, Youth and Culture, ABMA Building, 55–57, St. Vincent Street, Port-of-Spain (8.00 a.m. to 4.00 p.m. Monday to Friday);
 - (b) Administration Building, Jerningham Street, Scarborough, Tobago; and
 - (c) Offices of the Republic of Trinidad and Tobago Government Diplomatic Missions.
- 6. Completed application forms must reach the Scholarships and Advanced Training Division, Ministry of Human Development, Youth and Culture, preferably brought in by the applicants themselves at the above address, no later than 15th November, 2001.
- 7. Applicants who are Public Officers must submit their applications through their Permanent Secretaries/Head of Departments/Heads of Statutory Authorities as appropriate.
 - 8. Applications not submitted by the closing date or in accordance with the prescribed conditions will not be considered.
