VACANCY IN THE JUDICIAL AND LEGAL SERVICE

REGISTRAR, INDUSTRIAL COURT

Minimum Requirements

Experience (18 months to 4 years) in professional legal work as may have been gained in private practice or as a Legal Cadet and evidence of having been admitted to practice as an Attorney-at-law in Trinidad and Tobago.

Kind of Work

Responsible administrative and professional legal work.

Distinguishing Features of Work

An employee in this class is responsible for planning and directing the legal and administrative functions of the Industrial Court's Registry. Work involves the processing of all matters of the Industrial Court ensuring the proper maintenance and safe keeping of the Court's registers, records and documents. Work also includes scrutinizing collective agreements, preparing and issuing notices, summonses and performing such other specific functions as may be required by the Industrial Relations Act, Chap. 88:01 and supervising a group of subordinates engaged in clerical and accounting duties. Work is performed with considerable independence within the limits of relevant laws and established policies and procedures and is reviewed by a professional superior through reports, discussions and general observations.

Salary

Group IV: \$11,450-\$11,900 per month (1998).

Applications should be made on the Application for Promotion Forms. Applicants should submit their applications together with Curricula Vitae and Copies of relevant documents through their Permanent Secretaries and Heads of Departments to the Director of Personnel Administration, Service Commissions Department no later than 12th November, 2001.

Persons who applied previously and who are still interested in the office are required to re-apply.

Application forms are obtainable from any District Revenue Office, the Tobago House of Assembly or the Service Commissions Department.
