## GRENADA DRY FOREST BIODIVERSITY CONSERVATION PROJECT

THE GOVERNMENT OF GRENADA has received a grant from the Global Environment Facility (GEF) to implement the Grenada Dry Forest Biodiversity Conservation Project, a 4-year project which will be administered by the World Bank (WB) and implemented by the Forestry and National Parks Department, Government of Grenada. This project intends to promote the adoption of effective long-term strategies for conservation of Grenada's dry forest on public and private land by raising the awareness of key stakeholders of the importance of this habitat, providing key scientific information on this ecosystem, strengthening institutional capacity for forest management and by creating partnerships with the private sector to foster and support conservation activities. Applications are invited for the post of Project Manager.

## **Overall Responsibilities**

Under the direct supervision of the Chief Forestry Officer, Forestry and National Parks Department (FNPD), Ministry of Agriculture, Lands, Forestry and Fisheries, Government of Grenada, the Project Manager will be responsible for managing, supervising and ensuring co-ordination of the implementation and execution of Project activities.

## Duties and Responsibilities

To provide leadership and management for the efficient and effective implementation of the Project's objectives.

To manage day to day activities, including the recruitment and management of consultants and staff.

To co-ordinate and monitor the technical and financial aspects of each project component.

To prepare and review the annual work plans and budgets for each project component/activity.

To facilitate the procurement of goods and consultancies within the WB and Gov't. Grenada guidelines.

To liaise with the Biodiversity/Ecosystem Research Co-ordinator.

To facilitate partnerships with landowners to promote the conservation of key forest sites on private land.

To facilitate the imput of specialists from partner institutions in habitat conservation/wildlife management.

To co-ordinate short-term training imputs.

To liaise with the FNDP in the development of new forest legislation relating to dry forests.

To communicate on project issues to national policy makers, government departments, donors, other national stakeholders and the general public.

To participate in meetings and supervision missions involving the WB; and

To establish a monitoring and evaluation system for the Project.

## Remuneration and Consultancy Period

Salary will be commensurate with qualifications and experience. Employment will be in Grenada on a contractual basis for a period of two (2) years with the possibility of an extension. Job to begin in 2002.

## Qualifications
