INDEX OF RETAIL PRICES—APRIL, 2002

General Index:

The All Items Index of Retail Prices calculated from prices collected for the month of April, 2002 was 145.9 showing a decrease of 0.1% below the Index of March, 2002.

The All Items Index for January–April 2002, showed an increase of 4.4% over that for January–April, 2001. This compares with an increase of 5.5% showed in the Index for January–April, 2001, over the same period in 2000.

Section Indices

Food: The Index for this section decreased from 258.8 in March 2002, to 258.5 in April 2002 indicating a 0.1% fall in the price of food items over this period. Within the Food Section there was a decrease of 1.0% in the Index for Market Items. Contributing significantly to this decrease were falling prices of chicken, shrimp, melongene, carrots and tomato. This decrease in price was partly offset by an increase in the price of pumpkin, cucumber, cabbage and citrus fruits.

Price changes in this section accounted for a decrease of 0.1 point in the All Items Index.

Other Sections:

A further review of the data for April 2002, compared with March 2002, indicated that increases were recorded for Drink and Tobacco, 0.1% and Transportation, 0.1%. Decreases were recorded for Clothing and Footwear, 0.1%; Household operations, 0.5; and Reading, Recreation and Education, 0.3%.

Price changes in these sections had a negligible effect on the All Items Index.

Growth in consumer prices in April, 2002, compared with those of April, 2001, reflected in various sections of the Index is shown hereunder:
