INDEX OF RETAIL PRICES – JUNE, 2002

General Index:

The All Items Index of Retail Prices calculated from prices collected for the month of June, 2002 was 147.6 showing an increase of 0.8% over the Index for May, 2002.

The All Items Index for January–June, 2002, showed an increase of 4.3% over that for January–June, 2001. This compares with an increase of 5.6% showed in the Index for January–June, 2001 over the same period in 2000.

Section Indices:

Food: The index for this section increased from 261.3 in May, 2002, to 266.7 in June, 2002 indicating a 2.1% rise in the price of food items over this period. Within the Food Section there was an increase of 4.4% in the Index for Market items. Contributing significantly to this increase were rising prices of chicken, cabbage, garlic, carrots and sweet potatoes. This increase in price was partly offset by a decrease in the prices of tomatoes, cucumber, chive, thyme and celery.

Price changes in this section accounted for an increase of 1.1 point in the All Items Index.

Other Sections:

A further review of the data for June, 2002 compared with May, 2002 indicated an increase of 0.2% for Drink and Tobacco, while decreases of 0.1% and 0.3% were recorded for Clothing and Footwear and Household operations respectively.

Prices changes in this sections had a negligible effect on the All Items Index.

Growth in consumer prices in June, 2002, compared with those of June, 2001, reflected in various sections of the Index is shown hereunder:
