PUBLIC STATEMENT OF THE NATIONAL GAS COMPANY OF TRINIDAD AND TOBAGO LIMITED IN COMPLIANCE WITH SECTIONS 7, 8 and 9 OF THE FREEDOM OF INFORMATION ACT 1999

Under the Freedom of Information Act 1999 ("the Act"), The National Gas Company of Trinidad and Tobago Limited (NGC) is required by law to publish certain information for the benefit of the public. This includes the structure and functions of NGC and a list of categories of documents held by NGC. It also identifies those documents which are eligible for public access under that Act and sets out how to obtain same. The following information satisfies the legislative requirements of the Act.

The Act gives members of the public:

- 1. A legal right for each person to access information held by the Public Authority;
- A legal right for each person to have official information relating to him/herself amended where it is incomplete, incorrect or misleading;
- A legal right to obtain reasons for adverse decisions made regarding an applicant's request for information under the FOIA; A legal right to complain to the Ombudsman and to apply to the High Court for Judicial Review to challenge adverse decisions made under the FOIA.

- Purchase and sale of natural gas
- Transmission and distribution of natural gas
- · Collection and compression of low pressure natural gas
- Natural Gas market development, including project planning and development, investment facilitation and marketing promotion of Trinidad and Tobago as a competitive location for natural gas-based investments.
- Port, Marine and site infrastructure development and management
- Equity investment management

CORPORATE INFORMATION

The NGC's registered office is located at Orinoco Drive, Point Lisas Industrial Estate.

The Company is governed by a Board of Directors appointed by the Company's shareholder, the Corporation Sole. Four Board sub-committees assist in formulating and guiding the business and policies of the Company:-

- The Audit Committee
- The Finance Committee
- The Human Resources Committee
- The Tenders Committee

The Company's executive management team comprises of the President, four (4)Vice Presidents and the General Counsel.

COMPANY STRUCTURE

The four operating groups are:-

The Technical Operations Group whose functions comprise gas transmission and distribution; gas compression; engineering services relating to the construction of pipeline and related facilities as well as transport services, civil engineering works and materials management.

The Business Development Group carries out functions related to NGC's role as facilitator of gas-based development. These include project planning and development; project evaluation; strategic planning and research; marketing and promotion; and gas resource management.

The Legal Group provides legal, corporate secretarial, contracts administration, environment, safety, security, and commercial services.

The Finance and Administration Services Group provides accounts payable, accounts receivable, payroll, financial reporting, treasury services, risk management, information technology and administrative services.

There are three independent divisions:

The Corporate Communications Division provides community relations, public relations and information services.

The Human Resource Division whose functions comprise training and development, human resource planning, organization relations and compensation management.

The Internal Audit Division provides independent, objective assurance and consultancy designed to improve the organisation's operations.

EFFECT OF SCOPE OF BUSINESS ON MEMBERS OF THE PUBLIC

The framework for the scope of business of NGC and its affiliates is two-fold:

- 1) To maximize value from the Company's business transactions for the benefit of the people of Trinidad and Tobago by leveraging its competencies and unleashing its entrepreneurial spirit;
- To establish Trinidad and Tobago as a major player in the global natural gas business

In its course of business, the NGC does not normally deal directly with members of the general public.

PROCEDURE FOR ACCESSING OFFICIAL DOCUMENTS UNDER FOIA

How to Request Information

- 1) Requests and public services under the FOIA will be entertained between the hours of 10:00am and 2:30pm daily.
- 2) All requests for access to documents that are not readily available in the public domain are to be made on the *Request for Access to Official Document(s) Form* that is available from the Designated Officer or from the FOIA Unit.
- 3) Queries for amendments to documents containing personal information about the applicant are to be directed to the Designated Officer in the form of a letter.
- 4) To ensure prompt handling of requests, please address it to the Designated Officer of the National Gas Company of Trinidad and Tobago Limited.
- 5) Requests will be acknowledged as official when made on the prescribed form.
- 6) Applicants must provide sufficient information to enable the Designated Officer to identify the document(s) being requested.

Time Allowed

- 7) Applicants will be notified within thirty (30) calendar days or before whether or not the request is approved.
- 8) Applicants whose requests are incomplete or unclear will be informed of same by the Designated Officer who will make arrangements to meet with the applicant for consultation with a view to clarifying the request.
- 9) The time limit of thirty (30) days will be suspended while consultation with the applicant is being undertaken, and resumes on the day the applicant confirms or alters the request.
- 10) Applicants' whose request for documents is refused, will be notified by the Designated Officer in writing of the reasons for refusal. The Officer will consult with the applicant about alternative recourses that are open to him/her.

Fees and Charges

- 11) Details of charges for photocopies or purchase of documents will be determined based upon individual requests by applicants.
- 12) Applicants will be required to complete an official company invoice before funds are paid to the Cashier.
- 13) Regulations for fees under the FOIA are not yet in force and, except for duplication charges, documents will be provided for free.
