INDEX OF RETAIL PRICES-JULY, 2002

General Index:

The All Items Index of Retail Prices calculated for the month of July, 2002 was 147.3 showing a decrease of 0.2% below the Index for June, 2002.

The All Items Index for January–July, 2002, showed an increase of 4.1% over that for January–July, 2001. This compares with an increase of 5.7% showed in the Index for January–July, 2001 over the same period in 2000.

Section Indices

Food: The index for this section decreased from 266.7 in June, 2002, to 266.5 in July, 2002 indicating a 0.1% fall in the price of food items over this period. There were significant increases in prices for the following market items: citrus fruits, melongene and cabbage. However these prices were offset by significant decreases in the prices of chicken, tomatoes, pumpkin, sweet and Irish potatoes.

Price changes in the Food Section had a negligible overall effect on the All Items Index.

Other Sections

A further review of the data for July, 2002 compared with June, 2002, indicated that increases were recorded for Household Supplies and Services, 0.2% and Reading, Recreation and Education, 0.7%. Decreases were recorded for Meals Out, 0.2%; Clothing and Footwear, 0.5%; Housing, 0.8%; Household Operations, 0.3%; Health and Personal Care, 0.2%; Transportation, 0.3%.

Prices changes in these sections accounted for a decrease of 0.3 point in the All Items Index.

Growth in consumer prices in July, 2002, compared with those of July, 2001, reflected in various sections of the Index is shown hereunder:
