INDEX OF RETAIL PRICES-AUGUST, 2002

General Index

The All Items Index of Retail Prices calculated for the month of August, 2002 was 149.0 showing an increase of 1.2% above the Index for July, 2002.

The All Items Index for January–August, 2002 showed an increase of 4.0% over that for January–August, 2001. This compares with an increase of 5.9% showed in the Index for January – August, 2001 over the same period in 2000.

Section Indices

Food: The Index for this section increased from 266.5 in July, 2002 to 274.3 in August, 2002, indicating a 2.9% rise in the price of food items over the period. There were significant increases for the following market items: chicken, tomatoes, citrus fruits, Irish potatoes, chive, thyme and celery. However these prices were offset by decreases in the price of fresh fish, carrots, garlic, green bananas and plantain.

Price changes in this section accounted for an increase of 1.7 point in the All Items Index.

Other Sections

A further review of the data for August, 2002 compared with July. 2002 indicated that increases were recorded for Drink and Tobacco 0.1% and Health and Personnel Care 0.2%. While a decrease of 0.1% was recorded for Clothing and Footwear.

Price changes in this section had a negligible overall effect on the Index.

Growth in consumer prices in August, 2002 compared with those of August, 2001 reflected in various sections of the Index is shown hereunder:
