INDEX OF RETAIL PRICES-JANUARY, 2002

General Index

The All Items Index of Retail Prices calculated from prices collected for the month of January, 2002 was 147.2 showing an increase of 1.6% over the Index for December, 2001.

The All Items Index for January, 2002 showed an increase of 5.2% over that for January, 2001. This compares with an increase of 4.8% observed in the Index for January, 2001 over the same period in 2000.

Section Indices

Food: The Index for this section increased from 255.4 in December, 2001 to 264.2 in January, 2002 indicating a 3.4% rise in the price of food items over this period. Within the Food Section there was an increase of 8.3% in the Index for Market items. Contributing significantly to this increase were rising prices of chicken, tomatoes, melongene, and cucumber. These increases in prices were partly offset by a decrease in the prices of Beef, Citrus fruits and green bananas and plantains.

Price changes in this section accounted for an increase of 1.9 point in the All Items Index.

Other Sections

A further review of the data for January, 2002 compared with the previous month, indicated that increases were recorded for Drink and Tobacco, 0.2%; Housing 0.1%; Transportation 2.0% and Reading, Recreation and Education 0.3%. Decreases were recorded for Clothing and Footwear, 0.1% and Health and Personal care 0.5%.

Price changes in these sections accounted for an increase of 0.3 point in the All Items Index.
