- 2. The Civil Works Component of the Programme consists primarily of the rehabilitation of approximately five hundred and eighty-six (586) kilometres of main roads and reconstruction of sixty-five (65) kilometres of bridges and the improvement of approximately fifty (50) kilometres of trunk roads.

The scope of work and the consultancy service under this prequalification exercise will be to design, review and supervise Year 3 works on the Roads and Bridges Rehabilitation, National Highways Programme.
