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TENDERS FOR THE SUPPLY, DELIVERY, INSTALLATION, COMMISSIONING AND MAINTENANCE OF COMPUTER HARDWARE AND SOFTWARE FOR PRINCIPALS AND TEACHERS OF SECONDARY SCHOOLS AND THE CURRICULUM DEVELOPMENT DIVISION UNDER THE SECONDARY EDUCATION MODERNIZATION PROGRAMME (SEMP), MINISTRY OF EDUCATION, IDB LOAN 1180/OC-TT

The Government of the Republic of Trinidad and Tobago (GORTT) has obtained loan funding from the Inter-American Development Bank (IDB) for a Secondary Education Modernization Programme (IDB Loan No. 1180/OC-TT). One important aspect of this programme is the development of a modernized curriculum for secondary schools. This curriculum is currently being developed and implemented by the Division of Curriculum Development of the Ministry of Education. To facilitate the effective implementation of this programme, it is necessary to equip all principals with the necessary hardware, software and relevant computer training to develop and maintain continuous contact among the secondary schools and the Division of Curriculum Development, in relation to the implementation of the modernized curriculum. The software programme therefore, must be specifically designed to track the implementation of the curriculum; to provide feedback to the Curriculum Development Division on the technical issues of the curriculum in the following areas: Aesthetics, Language Arts, Mathematics, Physical Education, Social Studies, Science and Spanish.

In this regard, tenders are invited from eligible bidders for the following packages:

- (i) supply, delivery, installation, commissioning and maintenance of computer hardware for principals and teachers of secondary schools and the Curriculum Development Division, Ministry of Education under the SEMP; and
- (ii) design, supply, delivery, installation and commissioning of computer software and provision of software related training for selected staff of the Ministry of Education.

Contracts will be awarded for any package or combination of packages.
