THE GOVERNMENT OF THE REPUBLIC OF TRINIDAD AND TOBAGO is about to undertake major improvements to the Churchill-Roosevelt Highway (CRH). The Ministry of Works and Transport is the Executing Agency for the project.

- 2. The project is being financed entirely by the Government of the Republic of Trinidad and Tobago.
- 3. The scope of work of the consultants under this prequalification will be to provide design consultancy services for the improvements to the Churchill-Roosevelt Highway between O'Meara and Santa Rosa.
