Public Statement of National Enterprises Limited
In Compliance with sections 7, 8 and 9 of
The Freedom of Information Act, 1999 (FOIA)

In accordance with Sections 7, 8 and 9 of the Freedom of Information Act, 1999 (FOIA) the Public Authority is required by law to publish the following statements which list the documents and information generally available to the public.

The Act gives members of the public:

- (1) A legal right for each person to access information held by the Public Authority;
- (2) A legal right for each person to have official information relating to him/herself amended where it is incomplete, incorrect or misleading;
- (3) A legal right to obtain reasons for adverse decisions made regarding an applicant's request for information under the FOIA
- (4) A legal right to complain to the Ombudsman and to apply to the High Court for Judicial Review to challenge adverse decisions made under the FOIA.

Function and structure of National Enterprises Limited

Mission Statement:

National Enterprises Limited's mission is to broaden the base of the local stock market and allow participation by nationals in certain successful and mature enterprises of which the Government of Trinidad and Tobago is a shareholder.

The overall objective of National Enterprises Limited is to provide investors with a well-managed investment designed to meet the specific objectives of income and capital growth with some degree of spread of investment risks.

National Enterprises Limited is a publicly quoted limited liability company. The majority shareholder is the Government of the Republic of Trinidad and Tobago. National Enterprises Limited was incorporated on August 27, 1999 under the Companies Act 1995. It currently comprises a staff of one (1) and is headed by the Chairman of the Board of Directors. National Enterprises Limited is not yet divided into various responsibility centres.

Effect of functions on members of the public

National Enterprises Limited does not deal directly with members of the public except in relation to occasional queries by individuals about their shareholding.

How to Request Information:

General Procedure

Our policy is to answer all requests, both oral and written, for information. However, in order to have the rights given to you by the FOIA (for example the right to challenge a decision if your request for information is refused), you must make your request in writing.

Addressing Requests

To facilitate prompt handling of your request, please address it to the Designated Officer of National Enterprises Limited (see Section 7 (1) (a) (vi)).

Details in the Request.

Applicants should provide details that will allow for ready identification and location of the records that are being requested. If insufficient information is provided clarification will be sought from the applicant. If you are not sure how to write your request or what details to include, communicate with our Designated Officer.

Requests not handled under the FOIA

 A request <u>under the FOIA</u> will not be processed to the extent that it asks for information which is currently available in the public domain, either from this public authority or from another public authority (for example brochures and pamphlets etc.)

Responding to your Request

Retrieving Documents

National Enterprises Limited is required to furnish copies of documents only when they are in our possession or we can retrieve them from storage. Information stored in the National Archives or another storage centre will be retrieved in order to process your request.

Furnishing Documents

An applicant is entitled to copies of information we have in our possession, custody or power. We are required to furnish only one copy of a document. If we cannot make a legible copy of a document to be released, we may not attempt to reconstruct it. Instead, we will furnish the best copy possible and note its quality in our reply.

Please note we are not compelled to do the following:

- (a) Create new documents. For example, we are not required to write a new program so that a computer will print information in the format you prefer.
- (b) Perform research for you.

Time Limits

General

The FOIA sets certain time limits for us to decide whether to disclose the documents you have requested. If we fail to meet the deadlines, the FOIA gives you the right to proceed as if your request has been denied. We will try diligently to comply with the time limits, but if it appears that processing your request may take longer than the statutory limit, we will acknowledge your request and advise you of its status. Since there is a possibility that requests may be misaddressed or misrouted, you may wish to call or write to confirm that we have received the request and to ascertain its status.

Time Allowed

We will determine whether to grant your request for access to information <u>as soon as practicable but</u> <u>no later than 30 days</u> as required by Section 15 of the FOIA. If a decision is taken to grant access to the information requested, you will be permitted to inspect the documents or be provided with copies, if you so request.

Fees and Refunds

The Freedom of Information Fees and Charges Regulations prescribe the fees related to the search, retrieval and provision of documents. You are entitled to receive the document/s within seven days of payment of the relevant fee. If we fail to provide the information within the seven days period you are entitled to a refund of the fees paid in addition to access to the document/s requested.
