APPOINTMENT OF A PRIVATE WAREHOUSE

(Customs Act, Chap. 78:01)

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred upon the Comptroller of Customs and Excise under the Customs Act, Chap. 78:01, I, Kawanhar Doopan, Comptroller of Customs and Excise, acting under the provisions of section 263(2) of the said Act, do hereby appoint the place specified in the Schedule hereto to be a Private Warehouse for the storage, pending entry for home consumption or export, of the following goods, as shall be warehoused by or in the private warehouse of Messrs. Anthony P. Scott and Co. Ltd., at the Atrium, Don Miguel Extension Road, San Juan—frangrances, deodorants, juices, packaging (of paper) and miscellaneous medical items, e.g. condoms, gloves, etc. and such other goods as I may subsequently approve.

SCHEDULE

An enclosed area measuring 12.19 metres on the northern and southern sides and 21.34 metres on the eastern and western sides comprising a total of 260.13 square metres.

The walls of the building are constructed of concrete blocks and BRC wire to the top and the roof is covered with galvanised iron sheets.

The property is bounded on the north by an open area owned by Anthony P. Scott and Co. Ltd., on the south by a warehouse owned by Narinesingh, on the east by Toyota Bonded Warehouse and on the west by a road reserve.
