INDEX OF RETAIL PRICES—OCTOBER, 2002

General Index

The All Items Index of Retail Prices calculated for the month of October, 2002 was 149.7 showing a decrease of 0.1% over the Index for September, 2002.

The All Items Index for the period January–October, 2002, showed a 4.2% increase over that for the period January–October, 2001. A similar comparison of the Index for that period between the years 2000 and 2001 showed an increase of 5.8%.

Section Indices

Food: The index for this section decreased from 278.2 in September, 2002, to 277.5 in October, 2002, indicating a fall of 0.3% in food prices over that period. There were significant decreases in the price of the following market items: chicken, seafood: fish, crab, and shrimp, green bananas and plantains, melongene, tomatoes, and Irish potatoes. However, these price decreases were partly offset by increases in the price of pumpkin, sweet potatoes and citrus fruits.

Price changes in this section accounted for a decrease of 0.2 point in the All Items Index.

Other Sections

A further review of the data for October, 2002 compared with September, 2002 indicated that increases were recorded for the following: Meals out, 1.1%; Drink and Tobacco, 0.1%; Housing, 0.6%; Household Operations, 0.3%; Health and Personal Care, 0.8%. Decreases were, however, recorded for Household Supplies and Services, 0.1%; Transportation, 0.8%; and Reading, Recreation and Education, 0.5%.

Prices changes in these sections had a negligible net overall effect on the All Items Index.

Growth in consumer prices in October, 2002, compared with those of October, 2001, reflected in various sections of the Index is shown hereunder:
