APPOINTMENT OF A PRIVATE WAREHOUSE

(Customs Act, Chap. 78:01)

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred upon the Comptroller of Customs and Excise under the Customs Act, Chap. 78:01, I, Joseph A. Renaud, Acting Comptroller of Customs and Excise, acting under the provisions of section 2 and 263(2) of the said Act do hereby appoint a place specified in the Schedule hereto to be a Private/Customs Area for the storage of machinery, equipment, raw materials, semi-manufactured goods and other ingredients imported or taken out of bond by Genethics Pharmaceuticals Limited for the manufacture of Pharmaceuticals and Medicinal Products or other goods as may subsequently be approved.

SCHEDULE

Three areas are to be Bonded, in a Building situated at Lot No. 14, O'Meara Industrial Estate, O'Meara Road, Arima. The complete building is an area measuring 78.13 metres by 31.24 metres constructed of walls of concrete 9.38 metres high with a concrete roof and secured by steel doors, framed within the concrete walls on the northern side, southern side and western side of Genethics Pharmaceuticals Limited.

The property is bounded on the north by Steel Structures Limited, on the south by Cariflex Limited, on the east by General Packaging Limited and on the west by O'Meara Road.

TENDERS FOR THE ENGAGEMENT OF CONSULTANTS TO ASSIST WITH THE IMPLEMENTATION OF THE NATIONAL INFORMATION AND COMMUNICATIONS TECHNOLOGY PLAN, FASTFORWARD, FOR THE MINISTRY OF PUBLIC ADMINISTRATION AND INFORMATION

THE GOVERNMENT OF THE REPUBLIC OF TRINIDAD AND TOBAGO (GORTT) approved the establishment of consultative arrangements under the ambit and guidance of the Ministry of Public Administration and Information (MPA&I) for the preparation of a National Information and Technology (ICT) Plan. The Plan was finalized and launched in December, 2003. The Plan contains fourteen (14) programmes and about one hundred (100) associated projects that are to be implemented as part of the National ICT agenda. The National ICT Plan is now referred to as *fastforward* and is scheduled to be implemented by 2008. The GORTT is currently having ongoing discussions with the Inter American Development Bank with regard to seeking funding support for the implementation of *fastforward*. Information regarding *fastforward* and all of its associated programmes and projects can be found at www.fastforward.tt.

In this regard, the Ministry of Public Administration and Information wishes to issue Prequalification Documents for the identification of suitably qualified consulting firms to work with the Ministry and other partner organizations in implementing the following projects:

- Project 1: The engagement of a consulting firm to assist with the Design and Pilot Implementation of the Community Access Project.
- Project 2: The engagement of a consulting firm to assist with the Promotion and Awareness of Trinidad and Tobago's *fastforward* Agenda.
- Project 3: The engagement of a consulting firm to assist in the e-business development of an Online SME B2B market place and supporting activities.

“. . . and all seizures made under the Customs Laws or under any written law by which Officers are empowered to make seizures shall be deemed and taken to be condemned, and may be sold or otherwise disposed of in such manner as the President may direct, unless the person from whom such seizure shall have been made, or the master or owner thereof, or some person authorized by him, within one calendar month from the day of seizure, gives notice in writing to the Comptroller that he claims the thing seized, whereupon proceedings shall be taken for the forfeiture and condemnation thereof; but if animals or perishable goods are seized, they may by direction of the Comptroller be sold forthwith by public auction, and the proceeds thereof retained to abide the result of any claim that may legally be made in respect thereof”.
