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ENGAGEMENT OF CONSULTANTS TO ASSIST WITH THE IMPLEMENTATION OF THE NATIONAL INFORMATION AND COMMUNICATIONS TECHNOLOGY PLAN, *FASTFORWARD*, FOR THE MINISTRY OF PUBLIC ADMINISTRATION AND INFORMATION

THE GOVERNMENT OF THE REPUBLIC OF TRINIDAD AND TOBAGO (GORTT) approved the establishment of consultative arrangements under the ambit and guidance of the Ministry of Public Administration and Information (MPA&I) for the preparation of a National Information and Technology (ICT) Plan. The Plan was finalized and launched in December, 2003. The Plan contains fourteen (14) programmes and about one hundred (100) associated projects that are to be implemented as part of the National (ICT) agenda. The National ICT Plan is now referred to as *fastforward* and is scheduled to be implemented by 2008. The GORTT is currently having ongoing discussions with the Inter American Development Bank with regard to seeking funding support for the implementation of *fastforward*. Information regarding *fastforward* and all of its associated programmes and projects can be found at www.fastforward.tt.

In this regard, the Ministry of Public Administration and Information wishes to issue Terms of Reference for the identification and selection of suitably qualified consulting firms to work with the Ministry and other partner organizations in implementing the following projects:

- Project 1: The engagement of a consulting firm to assist with a Review of Legislation in support of Trinidad and Tobago's *fastforward* implementation.
- Project 2: The engagement of a consulting firm to assist with the National Broadband Strategy and Implementation Design Project.

Interested consulting firms may obtain the Terms of Reference and further information from addresses (1) and (2) below during the hours of 8.00 a.m. to 4.00 p.m. local time.

Bidders are requested to submit their proposals [original and five (5) copies] using two (2) envelopes clearly marked as follows:

- Envelope No. 1 Technical proposal for consulting services for the implementation of NICT Plan for the Ministry of Public Administration and Information— Project 1 or 2
- Envelope No. 2 Financial proposal for consulting services for the implementation of NICT Plan for the Ministry of Public Administration and Information— Project 1 or 2

Envelopes must be delivered to the second address (2) below and be deposited in the Brown Tenders Box located in the lobby of the Board's Office on or before 1300 hours on Thursday 2nd September, 2004. Technical proposals will be opened shortly after the closing at the Board's Office in the presence of bidders who choose to attend.
