**2154**TENDER FOR CONSULTANCY SERVICES FOR WRIGHTSON ROAD IMPROVEMENT PROJECT FOR  
THE MINISTRY OF WORKS AND TRANSPORT

THE GOVERNMENT OF THE REPUBLIC OF TRINIDAD AND TOBAGO (GORTT) through the Ministry of Works and Transport is desirous of undertaking road improvement works along Wrightson Road, St. Vincent Street to Colville Street in Port-of-Spain. The works are to address existing traffic problems in the area and are intended to improve traffic flows. Consultants are being sought by the Ministry of Works and Transport to provide the required consultancy services.

The objective of this consultancy is to improve traffic flows between Market Interchange (NP) and Colville Street, by initially increasing the westbound capacity of the most critical section of Wrightson Road that is, between St. Vincent Street and Colville Street.

The Central Tenders Board on behalf of the Ministry of Works and Transport now invites proposals from suitably qualified and experienced consultants to provide the required services.

Tender documents may be obtained during normal working hours at the Central Tenders Board's Office, 116, Frederick Street, Port-of-Spain.

Proposals must be accompanied by valid Income Tax and Value Added Tax Certificates and a Certificate of Compliance from the National Insurance Board.

Consultants are required to submit one (1) original and five (5) copies of their Technical and Financial Proposals using the two (2) envelope system. Envelopes must be addressed to the Chairman, Central Tenders Board, 116, Frederick Street, Port-of-Spain and deposited in the Brown Tenders Box, located in the lobby of the Board's Office not later than 1.00 p.m. on Thursday 25th November, 2004.

Envelope 2 —Financial Proposal"

Technical Proposals will be opened shortly thereafter closing on the same day at the Board's Office in the presence of interested consultants or their representatives who wish to attend.

Late tenders will not be accepted under any circumstances.

The cost of preparing the proposals and negotiating the contract are not reimbursable as a direct cost of the consultancy and the Central Tenders Board is not bound to accept any proposal submitted.
