EXPRESSION OF INTEREST

THE GOVERNMENT OF TRINIDAD AND TOBAGO (GORTT) has received a loan from the International Bank for Reconstruction and Development towards the implementation of the HIV/AIDS Prevention and Control Project and it intends to apply the proceeds of the loan to payments for some of the goods, works, related services and consulting services to be procured under this project. This project will include financing from the European Union and other funding agencies.

The GORTT in its effort to prevent and control the spread of the HIV/AIDS epidemic has developed a five-year National Strategic Plan (2003–2007) as the guide to Trinidad and Tobago national response to HIV/AIDS. The NSP sets out two overarching goals:

- (a) to reduce the incidence of HIV infections; and
- (b) to mitigate the negative impact of HIV/AIDS on persons infected and affected.

This project will include the following components:

- 1. Prevention of the Spread of HIV/AIDS
- 2 Treatment care and support
- 3. Advocacy and Human Rights
- 4. Surveillance and Research
- 5. Programme Management, Coordination and Evaluation.
