Renaud, Acting Comptroller of Customs and Excise, acting under the provisions of section 263(2) of the said Act, do hereby appoint the place specified in the Schedule hereto to be a Private Warehouse for the storage, pending entry for home consumption or export, of the following goods, as shall be warehoused by or in the private warehouse of Messrs. Vemco Limited of 9A, Diamond Vale Industrial Estate, Diego Martin—Skim milk powder, Full cream powder, Canned pineapple, Pineapple juice, Canned fruits, Dried prunes, Dried raisins, Almonds, Dates, Olives, Olive Oil, Canned meats, Canned tomatoes, Instant coffee, Power shake (energy drink) and such other goods as I may subsequently approve.
