INDEX OF RETAIL PRICES – DECEMBER, 2003

(Base: January, 2003 = 100)

The following Memorandum on the Index of Retail Prices is published for general information.

GENERAL INDEX

The All Items Index of Retail Prices calculated from prices collected for the month of December, 2003 was 103.1 representing a decrease of 0.1% over the Index for November, 2003, and an increase of 3.1% in the general price level over the 12 month period: January 2003–December 2003.

The annual rate of inflation as measured by the percentage change in the average All Items Index for the period January–December, 2003 over that for the period January–December, 2002 was 3.7%. This compares with an increase of 4.1% observed in the average All Items Index for January–December, 2002 over the average All Items Index for the same period in 2001.

The percentage change in the All Items Index of December 2003 when compared with December 2002 was 3.0%.

SECTION INDICES

FOOD AND NON-ALCHOLIC BEVERAGES:

The Index for Food and Non-Alcoholic Beverages decreased from 112.9 in November, 2003 to 112.8 in December, 2003, a decrease of 0.1%. Contributing significantly to this decrease was a general fall in the prices of chicken, fish, green bananas, and Fresh or Chilled Fruit, in particular: oranges, ripe bananas, and paw paw. Partly offsetting these decreases were significant price increases for the following items: tomatoes, melongene and dasheen.

Price changes in this section had a negligible net overall effect on the All Items Index.

OTHER SECTIONS

A further review of the data for December, 2003 compared with November, 2003 indicated decreases for the following: Alcoholic Beverages and Tobacco, 0.1%; Clothing and Footwear, 1.6% and Health, 0.1%.

Prices changes in these sections, for the month of December accounted for a net overall decrease of 0.1 point in the All Items Index.
