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TENDER FOR CONSULTANCY SERVICES FOR DETAILED ENGINEERING DESIGNS FOR IMPROVEMENT TO THE BEETHAM HIGHWAY FOR THE HIGHWAYS DIVISION, MINISTRY OF WORKS AND TRANSPORT

THE GOVERNMENT OF THE REPUBLIC OF TRINIDAD AND TOBAGO through the Ministry of Works and Transport is desirous of undertaking road development works along the Beetham Highway—from the Barataria Interchange to the Market Interchange. The works are expected to address existing traffic congestion, improve safety, improve the management of direct accesses and maximize the benefits to be garnered from existing and proposed improvement works along the Churchill-Roosevel Highway and Wrightson Road.

2. In this connection, the Central Tenders Board now invites proposals from suitably qualified consultants to provide consulting services for Detailed Engineering Designs for this project.
