APPOINTMENT OF COMMISSION OF ENQUIRY INTO ALLEGATIONS OF THE REMOVAL OF RESOURCES FROM THE SITE OF THE SCARBOROUGH HOSPITAL TO THE SITE CALLED "LAND DATE" AT MASON HALL AND THE CIRCUMSTANCES SURROUNDING THE AWARD OF ALL CONTRACTS MADE TO NH INTERNATIONAL AND WARNER CONSTRUCTION LIMITED FROM 2002 TO THE PRESENT

IN ACCORDANCE with section 15 of the Commissions of Enquiry Act, Chap. 19:01 of the Laws of the Republic of Trinidad and Tobago, it is hereby notified that His Excellency the President, Maxwell Richards, in the exercise of the powers vested in him under section 2 of the said Act, has issued a Commission appointing the persons named hereunder as Commissioners:

to enquire into-

- (a) the allegation of the removal of materials, equipment and resources from the site of the Scarborough Hospital to the site of a private project called "Land Date" at Mason Hall, Tobago, with particular reference to the following issues:
 - (i) whether the materials, equipment and resources were in fact removed in the circumstances as alleged;
 - (ii) if the materials, equipment and resources were in fact removed as alleged, whether there was any impropriety on the part of any Minister.
- (b) the circumstances surrounding the procurement processes and the award of all contracts made to NH International and Warner Construction Limited from 2002 to the present with particular reference to:
 - (i) whether the award of those contracts were made in accordance with the law and the established practices and procedures governing the award of public contracts;
 - (ii) whether there was any impropriety on the part of any person of authority in relation to the procurement process or the award of any contract to NH International or Warner Construction Limited; and
- (c) to make such observations and recommendations arising out of its deliberations as the Commission may deem appropriate.

His Excellency the President, Professor George Maxwell Richards further directed that:

- (a) Madame Justice Annestine Sealey be the Chairman of the Commission and that with due diligence and dispatch the Commission report to him within a period of not more than six (6) weeks from the date of the first sitting;
- (b) The enquiry be held in public but the Commissioners nevertheless be entitled in their discretion to sit in private;
- (c) A quorum of the Commission should consist of two (2) Commissioners; and
- (d) The Secretary to the Commission be Ms. Radhakah Charan-Ramdass.
