THE GOVERNMENT OF THE REPUBLIC OF TRINIDAD AND TOBAGO (GORTT) through the Ministry of Health (MOH) has initiated a comprehensive Health Sector Reform Programme (HSRP) aimed at improving the quality of health care by changing organizational structure(s) and behaviour(s).
