AN ACT to amend the Accreditation Council of Trinidad and Tobago Act, Chap. 39:06

[Assented to 7th July, 2008]

ENACTED by the Parliament of Trinidad and Tobago as ${\tt Enactment}$ follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the Accreditation Council Short title of Trinidad and Tobago (Amendment) Act, 2008.

Interpretation Chap. 39:06	2. In this Act, "the Act" means the Accreditation Council of Trinidad and Tobago Act.
Section 29 amended	3. The Act is amended in section 29, subsection (1), by deleting the words "four years" and substituting the words "five years".
Section 30 inserted	4. The Act is amended by inserting after section 29 the following section:
	"Provisional registration 30. (1) Notwithstanding section 8(2)(c), the Council may provisionally register a post secondary or tertiary institution which does not fulfil the requirements for registration, for a period not exceeding one year, if the Council believes that the post secondary or tertiary institution will be able to fulfil the relevant requirements within a reasonable period.

(2) The Council may extend the period referred to in subsection (1) for a further period not exceeding one year.".
