An Act to provide for the Service of Trinidad and Tobago for the financial year ending on the 30th day of September, 2009

[Assented to 10th October, 2008]

ENACTED by the Parliament of Trinidad and Tobago as Enactment follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the Appropriation Short title Act, 2009.

Issue from the Consolidated Fund authorized 2. (1) The issue from the Consolidated Fund of the sum of forty-four thousand, two hundred and six million, three hundred and thirty thousand, seven hundred and sixty-two dollars (\$44,206,330,762) is authorized for meeting expenditure for the service of Trinidad and Tobago for the financial year ending on the 30th day of September, 2009, under the Heads of Expenditure specified in the First Column of the Schedule.

Schedule

(2) The sum specified in the Second Column of the Schedule, in relation to the Head of Expenditure specified in the First Column of the Schedule, is appropriated out of the sum of forty-four thousand, two hundred and six million, three hundred and thirty thousand, seven hundred and sixty-two dollars (\$44,206,330,762) for the financial year ending on the 30th day of September, 2009.

Commencement

3. This Act shall come into force on the 1st day of October, 2008.
