AN ACT to amend the Assisted Secondary School Teachers' Pensions Act, Chap. 39:03

[Assented to 6th November, 2008]

ENACTED by the Parliament of Trinidad and Tobago as $_{\mbox{\sc Enactment}}$ follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the Assisted Secondary Short title School Teachers' Pensions (Amendment) Act, 2008.

	"Computation 11A. (1) Where a teacher who immedi- of pension ately prior to—
	capacity, prior to compulsory retirement (a) the date of his compulsory retirement; or
	(b) the date on which he proceeds on annual leave prior to the date of compulsory retirement,

has acted in a higher office for a period of three continuous years, that teacher shall be eligible to have his pension, gratuity or other allowance calculated as if he were confirmed in that higher office and for the purpose of computing such pension, gratuity or other allowance, he shall be deemed to be a teacher to whom regulation 11(1)(a) of the Regulations applies.

(2) Where a teacher who immediately prior to—

- (a) the date of his compulsory retirement; or
- (b) the date on which he proceeds on annual leave prior to the date of compulsory retirement,

has acted in a higher office for a period of one continuous year but less than three continuous years, that teacher shall be eligible to have his pension, gratuity or other allowance calculated as if he were confirmed in that higher office during that period and for the purpose of computing

such pension, gratuity or other allowance, he shall be deemed to be a teacher to whom regulation 11(1)(c) and (2) of the Regulations applies.

11B. (1) Where teacher who a is Computation of pension $_{\text{on promotion}}^{\text{or pension}}$ promoted to a higher office having acted in following that higher office retires compulsorily, and acting, prior to compulsory the period of acting together with his retirement service in the office to which he has been promoted amounts to a period of not less than-

- (a) three continuous years, he shall be eligible to have his pension, gratuity or other allowance calculated as if he had held that higher office during the entire period and for the purpose of computing such pension, gratuity or other allowance, he shall be deemed to be a teacher to whom regulation 11(1)(a) of the Regulations applies; or
- (b) one continuous year but less than three continuous years, he shall be eligible to have his pension, gratuity or other allowance calculated as if he had held that higher office during that period and for the purpose of computing such pension, gratuity or other allowance, he shall be deemed to be a teacher to whom regulation 11(1)(c) and (2) of the Regulations applies.

Commencement 11C. The provisions of sections 11A and 11B are deemed to have come into effect on January 1, 2005.".
