## TENDER FOR THE PROVISION OF SECURITY SERVICES TO THIRTY-EIGHT OFFICES OF THE MINISTRY OF SOCIAL DEVELOPMENT

TENDERS are invited for the provision of Security Services to thirty-eight (38) offices of the Ministry of Social Development for a period of two (2) years.

These offices are broken up into five (5) packages labelled A-E.

Tender documents including details of each package may be obtained during normal working hours at the Central Tenders Board's Office, 116, Frederick Street, Port-of-Spain.

Tenderers are required to pay a tender deposit of \$500.00 to the Director of Contracts, by cash or certified cheque and attach the original receipt to the tender.

Separate contracts may be awarded for each package or a combination of packages.

Prospective tenderers are advised to visit the sites and acquaint themselves with conditions which may influence their tender.

A pre-tender meeting will be held at 10.00 a.m. on Friday 1st February, 2008 at the Ministry of Social Development, 69, Independence Square, Port-of-Spain. Site visits will be arranged at the meeting.

Tenders must be accompanied by valid-

- (a) Income Tax Clearance Certificate;
- (b) Value Added Tax Clearance Certificate;
- (c) National Insurance Compliance Certificate.

Sealed tenders in duplicate on the approved Tender Form will be received up to 1.00 p.m. on Thursday 21st February, 2008. Envelopes must be addressed to the Chairman, Central Tenders Board and marked on the outside: "Tender for the Provision of Security Services to Thirty-Eight Offices of the Ministry of Social Development" and deposited in the Brown Tenders Box located in the lobby of the Board's Office.

Tenders will be opened shortly thereafter. The tenderer or his representative may be present at the opening.

The Central Tenders Board reserves the right to cancel the present notice in its entirety or even partially, without defraying any cost incurred by any firm submitting its tender.

Tenderers should note that the dimensions of the slot in the Tenders Box are 37.5 cm x 5.5 cm. Tenders should therefore be packaged accordingly.

Late tenders will not be considered in any circumstances.
