- 8. Exercises jurisdiction in family matters, affecting the custody and maintenance of children, matters of domestic violence and juveniles brought before the Court.
- 9. Adjudicates in ejectment proceedings (Landlord/Tenant disputes).
- 10. Serves on tribunals as required, e.g., Mental Health, Agricultural, etc.
- 11. Prepares and submits to the Court of Appeal, written reasons for decisions that are the subject to appeal.
- 12. Manages the proceedings in Court.
