# REGULATIONS

Made by the Commissioner of Police with the consent of the Minister of Works and Transport under section 67(1) of the Motor Vehicles and Road Traffic Act

# THE TRAFFIC CONTROL (EXPERIMENTAL SCHEME) REGULATIONS, 2008

- 1. These Regulations may be cited as the Traffic Control Citation (Experimental Scheme) Regulations, 2008.
- 2. These Regulations shall have effect from Monday 9th June, Commencement 2008 to Monday 8th September, 2008.

#### PART I

#### PORT-OF-SPAIN

- 3. Vehicular traffic shall proceed in both directions on Two-way Prada Street, from Newbold Street to Maraval Road.
- 4. Parking is prohibited on both sides of Hart Street from Parking St. Vincent Street to a point thirty metres eastwards.

### PART II

## St. James

5. Motorists shall proceed in—

One-way

- (a) a northerly direction on Coronation Street, between Mucurapo Road and Western Main Road; and
- (b) a southerly direction on Luckput Street, between Mucurapo Road and Western Main Road.
- 6. Motorists proceeding—

No right turn

- (a) north on Coronation Street, shall not turn right at the intersection with Western Main Road; and
- (b) west on Mucurapo Road, shall not turn right at the intersection with St. James Link Road.

Two-way traffic

- 7. Vehicular traffic shall proceed in either direction on—
  - (a) Carlton Avenue, between Coronation Street and Luckput Street; and
  - (b) St. James Link Road, between Western Main Road and Mucurapo Road.

#### PART III

#### SANGRE GRANDE

Parking prohibited

8. Parking is prohibited on Brierley Street, between Picton Road and Ojoe Road.

One-way traffic

- 9. Vehicular traffic shall proceed in—
  - (a) a westerly direction on Eastern Main Road, between George Street and Railway Road (Guaico Junction);
  - (b) an easterly direction on Railway Road Extension, between Eastern Main Road and Picton Road;
  - (c) an easterly direction on Brierley Street, between Picton Road and Toco Road;
  - (d) a southerly direction on Guaico Street No. 1, between Railway Road Extension and Eastern Main Road;
  - (e) a northerly direction on Guaico Street No. 3, between Eastern Main Road and Railway Road Extension;
  - (f) a southerly direction on Guaico Street No. 4, between Railway Road Extension and Eastern Main Road;
  - (g) a southerly direction on Short Street (Maxi-taxi Hub), between Railway Road Extension and Eastern Main Road;
  - (h) a northerly, then westerly and then southerly direction on River Road, between Eastern Main Road and Brierley Street;
  - (i) a southerly direction on Royal Castle Road, between Railway Road No. 1 and Eastern Main Road for Public Transport Service Corporation buses only;
  - (j) a northerly direction, between Eastern Main Road and Brierley Street;
  - (k) an easterly direction on Canton Street, between Paul Street and George Street;
  - (l) a westerly direction on Oxford Street, between George Street and Paul Street; and
  - (m) an easterly direction on Mory Street, between Paul Street and George Street.

# PART IV

#### GENERAL

- 10. A person who contravenes any of the provisions of these Offence and Regulations is liable on summary conviction for a first offence, to a fine penalty of seven hundred and fifty dollars, and on any subsequent conviction, to a fine of one thousand dollars.
- 11. Without prejudice to any other liability incurred by the Removal and commission of a summary offence, vehicles found parked in  $^{\rm impounding}_{\rm of\, vehicles}$  contravention of these Regulations, may be removed by the Police and unlawfully impounded and dealt with in accordance with section 108(1)(b) of the  $^{\rm parked}$  Motor Vehicles and Road Traffic Act.
