# ORDER

### Made by the Commissioner of Police under Section 68(1) of the Motor Vehicles and Road Traffic Act

#### THE TRAFFIC RESTRICTION (TEMPORARY PROVISIONS) (FORMAL OPENING OF THE 2008–2009 LAW TERM OF THE SUPREME COURT OF JUDICATURE OF THE REPUBLIC OF TRINIDAD AND TOBAGO) ORDER, 2008

1. This Order may be cited as the Traffic Restriction (Temporary <sub>Citation</sub> Provisions) (Formal Opening of the 2008–2009 Law Term of the Supreme Court of Judicature of the Republic of Trinidad and Tobago) Order, 2008.

2. This Order has effect from 6.00 a.m. to 2.00 p.m. on Tuesday Duration 16th September, 2008.

3. (1) Parking is prohibited on the following:

Parking

- (a) St. Vincent Street, between Duke Street and Independence prohibited Square North;
- (b) Sackville Street, between Richmond Street and St. Vincent Street;
- (c) Abercromby Street, between Independence Square North and Park Street;
- (d) Knox Street, between St. Vincent Street and Frederick Street;
- (e) Edward Street, between Independence Square North and Park Street;
- (f) Hart Street;
- (g) Duke Street, between Frederick Street and Edward Street;
- (*h*) Pembroke Street, between Knox Street and Park Street;
- (i) Henry Street, between Independence Square North and Park Street; and
- (j) Queen Street, between Frederick Street and Edward Street.

(2) Notwithstanding subclause (1), vehicles belonging to the Police Service and the Defence Force may park on the eastern side of Edward Street, between Queen Street and Sackville Street.

(3) Parking is prohibited on the grounds of the Red House.

# Traffic Restriction (Temporary Provisions) (Formal Opening of the 2008–2009 Law Term of the Supreme Court of Judicature of the Republic of Trinidad and Tobago) Order, 2008

4. (1) Vehicular traffic is prohibited from 9.00 a.m. to 1.00 p.m. on Roads closed to vehicular the following: traffic

- (a) St. Vincent Street, between Duke Street and Queen Street;
- (b) Hart Street:
- (c) Abercromby Street, between Independence Square North and Park Street;
- (d) Knox Street:
- (e) Queen Street, between Frederick Street and Edward Street; and
- (f) Edward Street, between Independence Square North and Sackville Street.

(2) Notwithstanding subclause (1), taxi drivers plying the St. Ann's route may access and park on Queen Street from Frederick Street.

Vehicular traffic diverted

- 5. From 9.00 a.m. to 1.00 p.m. motorists proceeding
  - east along Sackville Street, shall turn north onto Edward (a)Street;
  - west along Duke Street, shall turn south onto Frederick *(b)* Street; and
  - (c) south on St. Vincent Street, shall turn west onto Duke Street.

Taxi routes

- 6. Taxi drivers that ply—
  - (a) the St. Ann's route from Hart Street, shall operate from the southern side of Independence Square North, between Frederick Street and Henry Street; and
  - (b) the St. James route from Hart Street, shall operate from the western side of Henry Street, between Prince Street and Duke Street and the northern side of Independence Square North, between Frederick Street and Henry Street.

7. Without prejudice to any liability incurred by the Commission of Removal and a summary offence, vehicles found parked in contravention of this impounding Order may be removed by the Police and impounded and dealt with in of vehicles accordance with section 108(1)(b) of the Motor Vehicles and Road unlawfully Traffic Act. parked
