MADE BY THE MINISTER UNDER SECTION 18(2) OF THE
STANDARDS ACT

THE COMPULSORY STANDARDS ORDER, 2008

1. This Order may be cited as the Compulsory Standards Order, Citation 2008.

2. On the recommendation of the Trinidad and Tobago Bureau of Compulsory Standards, the following standards listed in the Second Column of the Schedule, which were notified in Legal Notice No. 15 of 2008, are hereby declared compulsory standards for the reasons set out in the Third Column of the Schedule.

3. This Order comes into effect on the 24th day of March, 2008. Commencement

TTS 569:2007	Automotive diesel fuel—Specification (1st Revision)	To protect the consumer or user against danger to health or safety; To protect the environment; and To ensure a minimum acceptable quality of automotive diesel fuel sold or used in Trinidad and Tobago.

TTS 601:2007	Plastic chairs—Performance requirements	To protect the consumer or user against danger to health or safety.
