Notice is hereby given that BP Trinidad and Tobago LLC is desirous of executing a new development project involving the installation of a 9-slot Well Projector Platform (WPP), drilling of five (5) wells from the WPP and the laying of a nine (9) kilometre, twenty-six (26) inch diameter sub-sea multiphase pipeline in the East Mayaro Block, off the South East Coast of Trinidad, and that this project is deemed a designated activity pursuant to the Certificate of Environmental Clearance (Designated Activities) Order, 2001, as amended by Certificate of Environmental Clearance (Designated Activities) (Amendment) Order, 2007, thus requiring a Certificate of Environmental Clearance ("the Certificate") pursuant to section 35 of the Environmental Management Act, 2000 ("the Act").
