INDEX OF RETAIL PRICES—August, 2010 (Base: January, 2003 = 100)

The following Memorandum on the Index of Retail Prices is published for general information.

GENERAL INDEX

The All Items Index of Retail Prices calculated from prices collected for the month of August, 2010 was 184.0 representing an increase of 4.0 points or 2.2% above the Index for July, 2010.

The annual rate of inflation as measured by the percentage change in the average All Items Index for the period January—August, 2010 over that for the period January—August, 2009 was 9.3%. This reflects a marginal reduction when compared with a rate of inflation of 9.4% observed in the average All Items Index for the period January—August, 2009 over the average All Items Index for the same period in 2008.

SECTION INDICES

FOOD AND NON-ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES

The Index for Food and Non-Alcoholic Beverages increased from 402.8 in July, 2010 to 424.5 in August, 2010, reflecting an increase of 5.4%. Contributing significantly to this increase was the general upward movement in the prices of fish—carite, sweet potatoes, irish potatoes, yams, christophene, melongene, green bananas, carrots, plantain, watercress, oranges, grapefruit, apples, limes, hot peppers, garlic and canned vegetables. However, the full impact of these price increases was dampened by a general decline in the prices of packaged rice, tomatoes, cucumber, ochroes, dasheen, eddoes, ripe bananas, avocado, celery, chive and mangoes.

Price changes in this section, for the month of August, 2010 accounted for a net overall increase of 3.9 points in the All Items Index

OTHER SECTIONS

A further review of the data for August, 2010 compared with July, 2010 reflected increases in the sub-indices for Alcoholic Beverages and Tobacco 0.2%; and Health 0.1%. However, a decline was noted in the sub-index for Clothing and Footwear 0.2%.

Price changes in these sections for the month of August, 2010 accounted for a net overall increase of 0.1 point in the All Items Index.
