INDEX OF RETAIL PRICES—September, 2010 (Base: January, 2003 = 100)

The following Memorandum on the Index of Retail Prices is published for general information.

GENERAL INDEX

The All Items Index of Retail Prices calculated from prices collected for the month of September, 2010 was 182.9 representing a decrease of 1.1 points or 0.6% below the Index for August, 2010.

The annual rate of inflation as measured by the percentage change in the average All Items Index for the period January—September, 2010 over that for the period January—September, 2009 was 9.8%. This reflects an increase when compared with a rate of inflation of 8.8% observed in the average All Items Index for the period January—September, 2009 over the average All Items Index for the same period in 2008.

SECTION INDICES

FOOD AND NON-ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES

The Index for Food and Non-Alcoholic Beverages decreased from 424.5 in August, 2010 to 418.1 in September, 2010, reflecting a decrease of 1.5%. Contributing significantly to this decrease was the general downward movement in the prices of sweet potatoes, yams, christophene, melongene, dasheen, watercress, ochroes, tomatoes, limes, hot peppers and spices. However, the full impact of these price decreases was offset by the general increase in the prices of carite fish, whole chicken, cucumber, cabbage, avocado, chive, celery, irish potatoes, oranges, paw paw and garlic.

Price changes in this section, for the month of September, 2010 accounted for a net overall decrease of 1.2 points in the All Items Index.

OTHER SECTIONS

A further review of the data for September, 2010 compared with August, 2010 reflected increases in the sub-indices for Clothing and Footwear 0.5% and Health 0.3%. However, a decline was noted in the sub-index for Alcoholic Beverages and Tobacco 0.1%.

Price changes in these sections for the month of September, 2010 accounted for a net overall increase of 0.1 point in the All Items Index.
