INDEX OF RETAIL PRICES-October, 2010 (Base: January, 2003 = 100)

The following Memorandum on the Index of Retail Prices is published for general information.

#### GENERAL INDEX

The All Items Index of Retail Prices calculated from prices collected for the month of October, 2010 was 180.6 representing a decrease of 2.3 points or 1.3% below the Index for September, 2010.

The annual rate of inflation as measured by the percentage change in the average All Items Index for the period January—October, 2010 over that for the period January—October, 2009 was 10.1%. This reflects an increase when compared with a rate of inflation of 8.1% observed in the average All Items Index for the period January—October, 2009 over the average All Items Index for the same period in 2008.

# SECTION INDICES

### FOOD AND NON-ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES

The Index for Food and Non-Alcoholic Beverages decreased from 418.1 in September, 2010 to 403.4 in October, 2010, reflecting a decrease of 3.5%. Contributing significantly to this decrease was the general downward movement in the prices of yams, sweet potatoes, ochroes, dasheen, christophene, celery, limes, green bananas, avocado and canned vegetables. However, the full impact of these price decreases was offset by the general increase in the prices of fish—carite and king fish, whole chicken, tomatoes, cucumber, melongene, watercress, paw paw, hot peppers and garlic.

Price changes in this section, for the month of October, 2010 accounted for a net overall decrease of 2.6 points in the All Items Index.

## OTHER SECTIONS

A further review of the data for October, 2010 compared with September, 2010 reflected increases in the sub-indices for Alcoholic Beverages and Tobacco 1.8%; Clothing and Footwear 0.2%; Home Ownership 0.6%; Rent 0.4%; Health 0.3%; Recreation and Culture 0.1%; Education 0.7%; Furnishings, Household Equipment and Routine Maintenance of the House 0.4%; and Miscellaneous Goods and Services 0.9%. However, a decline was noted in the sub-index for Hotels, Cafes and Restaurants 0.2%.

Price changes in these sections for the month of October, 2010 accounted for a net overall increase of 0.3 point in the All Items Index.
