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**TENDER FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF A HIGH SECURITY PERIMETER FENCE AT FARM ROAD, CUREPE
FOR THE MINISTRY OF FOOD PRODUCTION, LAND AND MARINE AFFAIRS**

TENDERS are invited for the Construction of a High Security Perimeter Fence around the Mandatory Citrus Virus Testing Laboratory and Office Compound of the Research Division, Farm Road, Curepe for the Ministry of Food Production, Land and Marine Affairs.

Tender documents can be collected during normal working hours at the Central Tenders Board's Office, 116, Frederick Street, Port-of-Spain.

Tenderers are required to pay a tender deposit of five hundred dollars (\$500.00) payable by cash or certified cheque to the Director of Contracts, Central Tenders Board, 116, Frederick Street, Port-of-Spain. This deposit will be received from Monday to Friday between the hours of 9.00 a.m. to 12.00 noon and 1.00 p.m. to 3.00 p.m. The original receipt must be attached to the tender.

A pre-tender meeting followed by a site visit will be held for prospective tenderers at 10.00 a.m. on Wednesday 15th June, 2011 at the Citrus Laboratory and Office Facility, Farm Road, Curepe.

Tenders must be accompanied by—

- (a) valid Income Tax and Value Added Tax Clearance Certificates issued by the Board of Inland Revenue and dated not more than six (6) months prior to the closing of the tender;
- (b) valid Certificate of Compliance issued in accordance with the National Insurance Act.

The original Tender Document and one (1) copy of the Form of Tender and Bill of Quantities must be placed in a sealed envelope, addressed to the Chairman, Central Tenders Board, 116, Frederick Street, Port-of-Spain, clearly marked on the outside: "Tender for the Construction of a High Security Perimeter Fence at Farm Road, Curepe for the Ministry of Food Production, Land and Marine Affairs".

The envelope must be deposited in the Brown Tenders Box located in the lobby of the Board's Office not later than 1.00 p.m. on Thursday 30th June, 2011.

Tenderers should note that the dimensions of the slot on the Tenders Box are 37.5 cm x 5.5 cm and tenders should therefore be packaged accordingly.

Tenders will be opened shortly thereafter. The tenderer or his representative may be present at the opening.
