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INDEX OF RETAIL PRICES—March, 2011 (Base: January, 2003 = 100)

THE following Memorandum on the Index of Retail Prices is published for general information.

#### GENERAL INDEX

The All Items Index of Retail Prices calculated from prices collected for the month of March, 2011 was 179.7 representing a decrease of 1.2 points or 0.7% below the Index for February, 2011.

The annual rate of inflation as measured by the percentage change in the average All Items Index for the period January–March, 2011 over that for the period January–March, 2010 was 10.8%. This reflects an increase when compared with a rate of inflation of 4.5% observed in the average All Items Index for the period January-March, 2010 over the average All Items Index for the same period in 2009.

#### SECTION INDICES

#### FOOD AND NON-ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES

The Index for Food and Non-Alcoholic Beverages decreased from 403.4 in February, 2011 to 396.6 in March, 2011, reflecting a decrease of 1.7%. Contributing significantly to this decrease was the general downward movement in the prices of tomatoes, yams, dasheen, ochroes, sweet potatoes, irish potatoes, melongene, bodie, christophene, chive, celery and hot peppers. However, the full impact of these price decreases was offset by the general increase in the prices of carite fish, eggs, carrots, cucumber, limes, oranges, paw paw, ripe bananas, green bananas, refined (yellow) sugar and canned vegetables.

Price changes in this section, for the month of March, 2011 accounted for a net overall increase of 1.2 points in the All Items Index.

#### OTHER SECTIONS

A further review of the data for March, 2011, compared with February, 2011, reflected increases in the sub-indices for Alcoholic Beverages and Tobacco 0.1%; and Health 0.1%. However, a decline was noted in the sub-index for Clothing and Footwear 0.1%.

Price changes in these sections for the month of March, 2011, had a negligible net overall effect on the All Items Index.
