## SCHEDULE ABOVE REFERRED TO—DESCRIPTION OF PIPELINE

<i>Description</i>	The proposed 457.20 mm (18-inch) diameter gas pipeline for the Toucan Field will begin at the Toucan Platform 67.59 km (42.00 miles) off the East Coast of Trinidad and head westward to a subsea tie-in on the proposed 914.40 mm (36-inch) National Gas Company (NGC), NEO pipeline. The pipeline will cross bpTT's east coast offshore acreage. Reference Map "A".
<i>Length</i>	26.32 km (16.36 miles).
<i>Specification of Pipeline</i>	Outside Diameter—457.20 mm (18.00 inches). Wall Thickness—22.23 mm (0.875 inch). Grade of Pipe—API 5L Gr X 60.
<i>Material of Construction</i>	Carbon Steel.
<i>Coating Specification</i>	External—2.48 mm (0.098 inches) External coating of High Density Polyethylene (HDPE). Internal—none. Concrete Coating—25.40 mm (1.00 inch) for 2 km of pipeline (KP 22–KP 24).
<i>Fabrication</i>	The pipeline will be welded in accordance with API Code 1104 and 100% of production welds would be subjected to non-destructive testing (NDT).
<i>Cathodic Protection</i>	The pipeline will be protected by sacrificial half shell aluminium zinc indium bracelet semi-tapered anodes.
<i>Depth of Line</i>	The pipeline will be laid on the seabed in a maximum water depth of 137.15 m (450 feet) and a minimum water depth of 45.72 m (150 feet).
<i>Fluid for Transmission</i>	Natural Gas.
<i>Maximum Allowable Operating Pressure (MOAP)</i>	153.06 barg (2220.00 psig).
<i>Design Pressure</i>	153.06 barg (2220.00 psig).
<i>Hydrotest Pressure</i>	191.33 barg (2775.00 psig).
<i>Estimated Capacity</i>	9.20 x 10 <sup>6</sup> m <sup>3</sup> /d (325.00 MMscf/d).
