Route The proposed 304.80 mm (12.00-inch) onshore natural gas pipeline pipeline will start at, landfall of the

Horizontal Directional Drill (HDD) shore approach, where it will connect to the offshore Tobago pipeline at Columbus Point, Tobago. The onshore pipeline will proceed in a northerly direction for 0.73 km (0.45 mile). It will turn northwest, travel 39.00 m (128.00 feet) and enter the Cove Estate. From here the proposed pipeline will extend west a further 33.00 m (108.00 feet) and terminate at the

proposed NGC Gas Receiving Facility. Reference Map "A".
